- Missouri resident
- No conflicting service obligations.
- **Upon licensure,** must engage in qualifying employment.



FORGIVENESS:

- Earned by working full time as a primary care provider in a Health Professional Shortage Area (HPSA) for 2-year service agreement, per loan award.
